Final text of the European Regulation on Artificial Intelligence approved: A Risk Based Approach

Given the digital revolution that is sweeping our era and the consequent exponential increase in the spread of Artificial Intelligence, on March 13, 2024 - after a long process that began in the spring of 2021 - the European Parliament approved the final version of the Regulation on Artificial Intelligence (so-called A.I. Act), intended to ensure uniformity of discipline within the different EU member states in relation to the development and use of Artificial Intelligence systems.

An Artificial Intelligence System is defined as a machine-based system designed to operate with varying levels of autonomy that may exhibit adaptiveness after deployment and that, for explicit or implicit objectives, infers, from the input it receives, how to generate outputs such as predictions, content, recommendations or decisions that can influence physical or virtual environments.
